IRONGROUN — A 3-year-old boy was killed in a mobile home fire on Monday, firefighters said.

Firefighters say Nicholas Allen was apparently playing with a cigarette lighter in the bathroom when the fire broke out. The boy had been pushed the last time he played with the lighter under the sink.

Firefighters found his body near the sink.

Lisa Hayes searched for the boy through the smoke in the trailer. She got her two other children — Kyle, 5, and Lindsay, 2 — outside without harm.

"The tragedy is that the boy was found near the sink when he was still in the bed, but didn't touch or see the boy," she said.

Hayes crawled out the front door, and the flames shot out the windows and doors, Gibson said.

The family is staying with Hayes' mother in Henderson. There was no smoke detector in the trailer.
